## Pinoy rock and rhythm is alive

SEASONED radio broadcaster and 2001 NU Rock Awards Lifetime Achievement (Hall Of Fame) Awardee Dante David, better known as "Howlin' Dave" of the 70's "Pinoy Rock And Rhythm: Sariling Akin," brings back the "oldies but goodies" Pinoy rock classics with his signature radio program "Pinoy Rock And Rhythm" Sunday afternoons at DWRT Rock 990 on the AM band.

Howlin' Dave carried the torch of Pinoy rock and roll in

the '70s, was lead vocals of heavy metal acid rock band Anak Bayan.

He discovered pioneers in the Philippine alternative music scene such as Juan Dela Cruz band, Sampaguita, Maria Calra, The Dawn, Mike Hanopol, Put3Ska, among others. He also introduced punk rock in the local scene, hosted alternative rock concerts in Club Dredd and others and was one of the pioneering rock jocks of DZRJ's The Rock of Manila.
